Summer Azure	Common from this time	Mid June
Fathead Minnow	Spawning in Creeks	Mid June
Red Fox	Young out of den	Mid June
Wild Parsnip	Full Bloom	Late June
Hawthorn Orange Spot	Appear on leaves	Late June
Red-eyed Vireos	Calls incessantly	Late June
Monarchs	Caterpillars on Milkweed	Late June
White-tailed Deer	Horns growing	Late June
Wild Leek	Full Bloom	Early July
Clavulina sp.	Appear after rains	Early July
Common Nighthawk	Calls through the night	Early July
Dion Skipper	Common from this time	Early July
Bullfrogs	Calls in large marshes	Early July
Black-eyed Susan	Full Bloom	Mid July
Common Milkweed	Full Bloom	Mid July
Galls on Red Oak leaves	Common from this time	Mid July
Sanderlings	Fall Migration	Mid July
Black Swallowtail	Common from this time	Mid July
Alewife	Last Spawning begins	Mid July
Common Cattail	Full Bloom	Late July
Early Goldenrod	Full Bloom	Late July
Maple Verticillium Wilt	Leaves show wilt	Late July
Semipal. Sandpipers	Fall Migration	Late July
Cicadas	Calls days above 28°C	Late July
Moose	Young half grown	Late July
Staghorn Sumach	Gone to seed	Early August
Spotted Joe-Pye-Weed	Full Bloom	Early August
Semipalmated Plover	Fall Migration	Early August
Peck's Skipper	2nd Brood Common	Early August
Eastern Toad	Small toads in numbers	Early August
Domestic Apple	In Fruit	Mid August
Boneset	Full Bloom	Mid August
Nectria Canker on Maple	First appearances	Mid August
Bay Breasted Warbler	Fall Migration	Mid August
Fall Webworm	Tents on Rosa sp.	Mid August
Red-osier Dogwood	Echo Bloom	Late August
New England Aster	Full Bloom	Late August
Willow Pine Galls	First appearances	Late August
Magnolia Warbler	Fall Migration	Late August
Pearl Crescent	3rd Brood Common	Late August
